Come to the Bead Shop Hop!

Attention, Attention! Did you know that there is going to be a Bead Shop Hop in September? It is going to be a must do for anyone in the San Diego/Los Angeles area who loves beads! Gather up all of your friends and read on about it!

What is a Bead Shop Hop? Bead Shop Hops are organized events where participating bead stores welcome all registered shop hoppers with a free gift and surprises. The stores in each region are all within approximately a 300-mile radius of one another. These hops take place over week to 1 or 2 weekends in a specific month. Holding the event over two weekends for the larger Bead Shop Hop gives ample time to visit all of the participating stores while collecting stamps for your passport. The stamps you collect for your passport make you eligible to win one of several great prizes being offered. Visiting all the stores in a specific region will give each shop hopper several projects to finish.

What happens during these Bead Shop Hops? So many things happen during the Bead Shop Hop - socializing, shopping, gawking, and enjoying your time with friends and family. They provide you with well deserved time to ditch every day distractions and get creative. As you visit, or "hop", from store to store you'll be invited to participate in various seminars and/or make-n-take projects. You can learn how to tie knots to stitching techniques. Also, each participating store you visit will stamp your passport and gift you a 'thank you' gift for visiting their store.

What is a Passport? Before your scheduled shop hop begins can register for a JUMP START gift and pick up both the JUMP START gift and your Bead Shop Hop Passport on the day you begin your Bead Shop Hop. There are two options for you. One is a FREE version, or you can opt for the extended color version that comes with over 200 coupons from participating stores and restaurants in the area. The FREE version will give you directions to the two closest stores only and will not include a detailed list of all the participating stores, their addresses or list of prizes and other important information (A list of participating stores can also be found at www.bead-shophop.co m You will need to bring your Passport with you throughout the hop, from store to store to obtain stamps for the stores that you visited.

How do I find out when and where the next hop is happening? Bead-Shop Hop works closely with stores in various parts of the United States organizing local Bead Shop Hops. If you would like to suggest an area for us to come visit please email us today!

How do I sign up for a Brick and Mortar shop hop? You can register and receive you 'JUMP START' gift at any participating store. You will pick up your gift when the Bead Shop Hop begins. JUMP START registration usually begins approximately 6 weeks prior to the event. And then get your shoes, gather your friends and you'll be shop hopping in no time!

CRAFTY How-To:

PAPER OR PLASTIC? WHAT TO DO WITH ALL THOSE SHOPPING BAGS?

Do you have a large stash of plastic shopping bags that clutter your kitchen? Why not turn those bags into a fused plastic tote that you can take with you anywhere!

Supplies:

- A good supply of plastic shopping bags of varying colors
- Scissors
- An iron
- Parchment paper
- Sewing machine

First, choose the bags you want to use. If you don't have shopping bags, you can always hit up the recycling bin at your local grocery store! Next, take your bags and slice off the handles, the bottom seams, and one side seam so they lay flat. You want to layer your bags about 4-6 layers thick. If you have a particular bag that has an image you want to show, then place that bag under a clear bag so that the ink from the image doesn't rub off when you heat it with the iron. You may want to cut out some shapes and include those in your layers Place a sheet of parchment paper on top and on the bottom of the bags, like a sandwich, to protect your iron and ironing board. Turn your iron to a med-high heat and work in a ventilated area. Start fusing slowly by moving the iron over the entire area for about 20 seconds at a time. Let the area cool and then check to see if the plastic is fusing

by looking for a "wrinkled" texture and a stiffer feel to the overall piece. Go slowly and keep heating until your bags are fused. To make a larger piece of fused plastic "fabric", lay the fused bags together and stitch to form a single piece. Cut out and sew up a new bag using your fused plastic fabric! You can use a purchased sewing pattern or create one of your own! Add handles and voilà!



Gemini: American architect, interior designer and writer, Frank Lloyd Wright was a Gemini, born on June 8th. He is known as "the greatest American architect of all time".


