

I was looking through a catalog of craft books and was really excited! I found a book by Jennifer Perkins of the Naughty Secretary Club, a fellow Craft Mafia member! Well, I'm personally about, "keeping it in the family," so I decided to support her and buy her book. I clicked on my computer, and ordered it! I was waiting for it to come in the mail, I couldn't wait!!! Finally it was here. I opened the book and felt right at home. CRAFTY HOW TO: MAKE A STAR PINATA!

What you will need:

- 1 Balloon
- Newspaper cut into srips
- Flour & water paste
- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Tissue paper in various colors
- Stapler

How to make it:


Blow up balloon and hang from ceiling. Dip newspaper strips into flour & water paste. Remove excess paste and place strips on balloon until completely covered. Allow it to dry overnight.

Tie heavy-duty string around the balloon twice from bottom to top and make a loop at the top with the ends of the string. This is what you will use to hang the piñata later.

Shape 5 pieces of construction paper into cones securing them with tape. Fringe the edges and attach to balloon in star pattern with newspaper strips dipped in paste.

Cut tissue paper into strips 5-6 inches wide. Fold the tissue paper vertically. Open the paper and turn inside out. Glue the uncut edges together. (Figure A) Decorate the cones and the balloon with these tissue paper loops starting from the tip of the cone progressing to the balloon. (Figure B). Staple or glue tissue paper streamers to the ends of the cones. After piñata is completely decorated, pop the balloon and fill with candy. Cover the hole in the top with tissue paper and hang to be broken.

for fun ideas for your 13/4 cups granulated sugar Cinco de Mayo party, ½ cup (1 stick) butter, softened

½ tsp baking soda

1/4 tsp salt

1 cup lemon or plain yogurt

LIME GLAZE AND **ASSEMBLY:**

½ cup superfine sugar 2 Tbs fresh lime juice (preferably Mexican limes)

Servings: 16

1 Tbs water

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F. Grease and flour a 9×13inch cake pan.
- 2. Prepare cake: Combine sugar, butter, baking soda and salt in a mixing bowl and beat until blended, add the eggs 1 at a time, beating well and scraping the bowl after each addition. Mix in the lemon zest and lemon juice. Add the flour and yogurt alternately, beating well after each addition.
- 3. Spoon the batter into prepared pan. Bake for 25 to 30 minutes or until a wooden pick inserted in the center comes out clean. Cool in the pan on a wire rack for 15 minutes.
- 4. Prepare glaze: Combine sugar, lime juice and water in a saucepan and mix well. Cook until the sugar dissolves, stirring frequently. Stir in the tequila.
- 5. Assembly: Invert the warm cake onto a serving platter and brush with the glaze until it is absorbed. Let stand until cool. Slice and garnish each serving with a twisted lime slice and a dollop of whipped cream.

Cooking Tips:

*If you're having trouble inverting the cake onto a serving platter, or if you're afraid that it might fall apart, it's ok to just spoon the glaze over the top of the cake while it's in the pan. Then cut neat slices and transfer to a serving platter.
